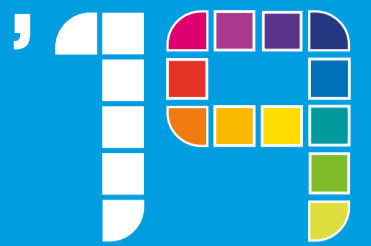


European Parliamentary Election

Are you ready to vote on Thursday 23 May 2019?

In order to vote you must be registered to vote. If you returned your completed annual voter registration form then you should be on the electoral register and that's the first step you need to take to make sure you can vote at the European Parliamentary Election on Thursday 23 May 2019. If you have moved recently, or are unsure if you are on the register, contact the Electoral Registration Office on the number below.

Deadline: If you are not registered to vote you must register by **midnight on Tuesday 7 May 2019**.

What's next?

Make sure the voting arrangements in place suit your circumstances at the time of the election. If you are going away on holiday on polling day, or you are working, or prefer not to go to the polling station, do you know you can:

- vote by post
- ask someone to vote on your behalf (ie by appointing a proxy)

Deadlines: If you wish to apply for a postal vote or make changes to your existing arrangements you must do this by **5pm on Wednesday 8 May 2019**.

If you wish to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf you must do this by **5pm on Wednesday 15 May 2019**.

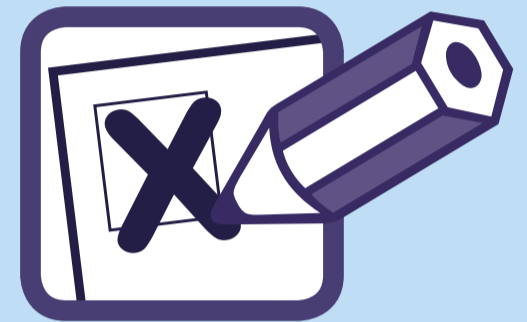
What are you voting for?

In Scotland you are represented by six Members of the European Parliament (MEPs). All MEPs elected will have equal status.

In the UK there are 73 MEPs.

How do I vote?

Vote only once by putting a cross in the box next to your choice.

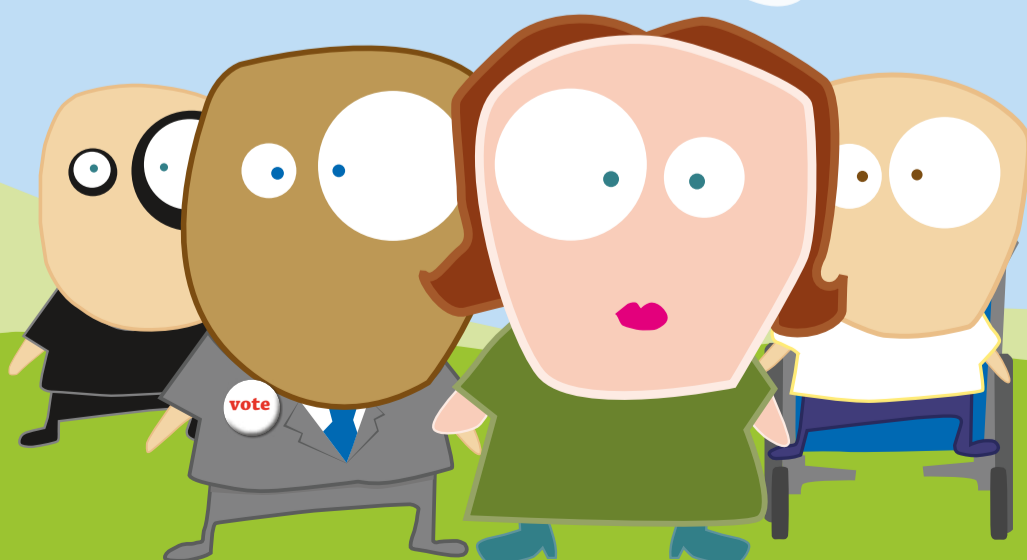
